1. Introduction

Morogoro Vocational Teachers Training College (MVTTC) was established in 1997 by the VET Act (CAP 82), MVTTC is registered by the National Council for Technical and Vocational Education and Training (NACTVET) as a Technical Institution with Registration Number REG/BTP/128 mandated to offer Technical and Vocational Teacher Education programmes.

1.1 Admissions Information

MVTTC is hereby announcing and inviting admission applications for Technical and Vocational Teacher Education programmes for September Intake 2025/2026 from applicants who possess relevant technical and/or vocational qualifications in any of the following fields/occupations but not limited to:- Civil Engineering, Electrical and Electronics Engineering, Automotive Engineering, Agriculture and Food Science, Commercial and Business Studies, Clothing and Textile Technology, Geomatics/Land Surveying, Mining and Mineral Processing, Transportation, Printing Technology, Mechanical Engineering, Information and Communication Technology, Hospitality and Tourism, Laboratory Technologies, Fine and Performing Arts, and Cosmetology.

1.1.1 Ordinary Diploma in Technical and Vocational Teacher Education (NTA Level 6) Entry Requirements

Possession of an Ordinary Diploma (NTA Level 6) in Technical or Vocational fields or its equivalent from recognized institutions.

Duration

The duration of study for this programme is Two Years (2).

1.1.2 Certificate of Assistant Vocational Teacher (CAVT)

Entry requirements

i) Certificate of Secondary Education Examination (CSEE) with at least two (2) passes excluding religious subjects

AND

ii) Possession of the National Vocational Award (NVA Level III) or Trade Test Grade One or its equivalent.

Duration

The duration of study for this programme will be One Year (12 months).

1.1.3 Ordinary Diploma in Civil and Construction Engineering with Technical and Vocational Teacher Education (NTA Level 6)

Entry Requirements

Certificate of Secondary Education Examination (CSEE) with a minimum pass 'D' in any TWO Subjects (passes from religious subjects are not counted) and a National Vocational Award (NVA) Level 3 in Civil Engineering trades from recognized technical or vocational education and training institution.

OR

Holder of Certificate of Secondary Education Examination (CSEE) with a minimum pass of 'D' in FOUR subjects, TWO of which MUST either be Mathematics, Physics/Engineering Science, Chemistry or English language or Technical Subjects from Technical Secondary Schools.

Duration

The duration of study for this programme will be three (3) years attended Full-Time

1.1.4 Ordinary Diploma in Electrical Engineering with Technical and Vocational Teacher Education (NTA Level 6)

Entry Requirements

Certificate of Secondary Education Examination (CSEE) with a minimum pass of 'D' in any TWO Subjects (passes from religious subjects are not counted) and NATIONAL VOCATIONAL AWARD (NVA) Level 3 in Electrical Engineering trades from recognized Technical or Vocational Education and Training institution.

OR

Holder of Certificate of Secondary Education Examination (CSEE) with a minimum pass of 'D' in FOUR subjects, TWO of which MUST either be Mathematics, Physics/Engineering Science, Chemistry or English language or Technical Subjects from technical schools.

Duration

The duration of study for this programme will be three (3) years attended Full-Time

1.1.5 Ordinary Diploma in Mechanical Engineering with Technical and Vocational Teacher Education (NTA Level 4–6)

Entry Requirements

Certificate of Secondary Education Examination (CSEE) with a minimum pass of 'D' in any TWO Subjects (passes from religious subjects are not counted) and National Vocational Award (NVA) Level 3 in Automotive or Mechanical Engineering trades from recognized Technical or Vocational Education and Training Institution.

OR

Holder of Certificate of Secondary Education Examination (CSEE) with a minimum pass of 'D' in FOUR subjects, TWO of which MUST either be Mathematics, Physics/Engineering Science, Chemistry or English language or Technical Subjects from technical secondary schools.

Duration

The duration of study for this programme will be three (3) years attended Full-Time

1.1.6 Ordinary Diploma in Automotive Engineering with Technical and Vocational Teacher Education (NTA Level 4– 6)

Entry Requirements

Certificate of Secondary Education Examination (CSEE) with a minimum pass of 'D' in any TWO Subjects (passes from religious subjects are not counted) and National Vocational Award (NVA) Level 3 in Automotive or Mechanical Engineering trades from recognized Technical or Vocational Education and Training institution.

OR

Holder of Certificate of Secondary Education Examination (CSEE) with a minimum pass of 'D' in FOUR subjects, TWO of which MUST either be Mathematics, Physics/Engineering Science, Chemistry or English language or Technical Subjects from technical secondary schools.

Duration

The duration of study for this programme will be three (3) years attended Full-Time.

1.1.7 Ordinary Diploma in Food Processing (NTA Level 4- 6)

Entry Requirements

A holder of Certificate of Secondary Education Examination (CSEE) with at least four (4) passes in non-religious including, one pass from among the following subjects: Agriculture, Geography, Nutrition, Biology, Chemistry and Physics.

Or

A holder of Trade Test Grade I / National Vocational Award Level III in Agro-mechanics, Animal Husbandry, Food Production, Laboratory Assistant (LA), and Food & Beverage Services & Sales (FBSS) certificate issued by VETA with a Certificate of Secondary Education Examination (CSEE) with a at least two (2) passes in non-religious subjects.

NOTE: Applicants with Foreign Secondary Certificates and Vocational Certificates must have the National Examination Council of Tanzania (NECTA) and NACTVET Equivalence translations respectively.

Duration

The duration of study for this programme will be three (3) years attended Full-Time.

Mode of Study

MVTTC offer its training in two modes namely In-Campus and ODeL

2.1 In-Campus Mode

The following programmes will be offered through In-Campus mode, attended at MVTTC;

- I. Ordinary Diploma in Civil and Construction Engineering with Technical and Vocational Teacher Education (NTA Level 6).
- II. Ordinary Diploma in Electrical Engineering with Technical and Vocational Teacher Education (NTA Level 6).
- III. Ordinary Diploma in Mechanical Engineering with Technical and Vocational Teacher Education (NTA Level 6).
- IV. Ordinary Diploma in Automotive Engineering with Technical and Vocational Teacher Education (NTA Level 6).
- V. Ordinary Diploma in Food Processing (NTA Level 6).
- VI. Ordinary Diploma in Interior Design and Decoration (NTA Level 6).
- VII. Ordinary Diploma in Technical and Vocational Teacher Education-OD-TVTE (NTA Level 6).
- VIII. Certificate of Assistant Vocational Teacher (CAVT) programme.

2.2 The Open and Distant e- Learning (ODeL)

This mode of learning will be applicable only for the Ordinary Diploma in Technical and Vocational Teacher Education–OD–TVTE (NTA Level 6) and Certificate of Assistant Vocational Teacher (CAVT) programmes will be offered through a blended Online Based Learning with scheduled Face to Face tutorials through the following centres:

- II. Lake Zone (Mwanza RVTSC).
- III. Central Zone (Dodoma RVTSC).
- IV. Highland Zone (Iringa RVTSC).
- V. Dar es Salam Zone (VETA Dar es Salaam RVTSC).
- VI. Western Zone (VETA Tabora RVTSC).
